Interpretation:

Moderate or severe magnesium deficiency is usually due to losses of magnesium from gastrointestinal tract or kidneys as in vomiting and diarrhoea in former and alcohol, diabetes mellitus (osmotic diuresis), loop diuretics (furosemide) and aminoglycoside antibiotics in latter.

Symptomatic hypermagnesemia is almost always caused by excessive intake with concomitant renal failure, thereby decreasing the ability of the kidneys to excrete excess magnesium.
