Interpretation:

Increased level found in liver diseases (acute hepatitis, cirrhosis, infectious mononucleosis) , hyper-parathyroidism, diabetes mellitus. Decreased level found in malnutrition, scurvy, zinc/magnesium deficiency, Post-menopausal women with osteoporosis taking estrogen replacement therapy, therapeutic agents (eg. Corticosteroids, trifluoperazine).



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
