- 1.This is a major adrenal androgen also produced by the testes and ovaries.
- 2.It is increased in polycystic ovarian disease,hirsutism,virilization,congenital adrenal hyperplasia,adrenal and ovarian tumors and Cushings disease, pregnancy and exercise .
- 3.It is decreased in Addison's disease.
