Test Description :

Islet cells antibodies are associated with " autoimmune " endocrine disorders and insulin dependent diabetes. They are used as

1. Marker of autoimmune pancreatic beta cell destruction.
2. Early indicator of IDDM.
3. Predictor of preclinical beta cell destruction.
4. Screening test for sibling of IDDM patients.

Technique:

BIOCHIP slide with frozen sections of Monkey pancreas is used.

Associated Tests :

1. GAD Antibody.
2. Insulin Antibody.

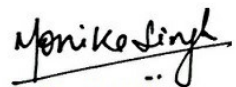
