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**Interpretation:**

1. Before reporting, all negative results are rechecked by Microscopy.
2. Cryptococcosis is an opportunistic infection, occurring in immunocompromised patients. After a primary pulmonary phase, the infection disseminates to the CNS and other organs.
3. Cryptococcal diagnosis is based on microscopy, culture and detection of soluble antigens in serum and CSF.
4. Cryptococcal antigen detection test is a latex agglutination test, which utilises monoclonal antibodies against *C.neoformans* capsular antigen.
5. Quantitative test is used to assess the stage and dissemination of the infection and for therapeutic monitoring.
