Fecal Calprotectin

Fecal Calprotectin Method : (Stool,EIA)	<12.5	mg/Kg	Negative: < 40 mg/Kg Equivocal: 41-59 mg/Kg Positive: >= 60 mg/Kg
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Interpretation:

Calprotectin is a protein present in neutrophils and its high concentration in the stools is a sign of inflammation. High levels are observed typically in patients with UC (ulcerative colitis), Crohn's disease (CD), colic, gastric and oesophageal neoplasms. Further, an increase of values can be observed in all the pathologies that involve the activation of an acute or chronic inflammatory process of the gastrointestinal system. Anti-inflammatory medications may vary the Calprotectin levels.
