Glutamate Decarboxylase 65 (GAD 65) Antibody Paraneoplastic Syndrome

Interpretation:

Antibodies against GAD are found in the serum and CSF of 60 % - 100% of patients with stiff-person syndrome(a rare neurological disease with progressive muscle frigidty ,spasms and resulting skeletal deformations.) or its clinical variants (Stiff Limb Syndrome ; progressive encephalomyelitis with rigidity and myoclonia) GAD specific antibodies can also occur in cases of non paraneoplastic limbic encephalitis or cerbellar ataxia.




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
