Note

1. This is a qualitative assay for detection both IgM & IgG antibodies to Hepatitis B core Antigen which persists indefinitely.
2. Reactive test result indicates Hepatitis B virus infection.
3. This assay does not stratify the stage of Hepatitis B Virus (HBV) infection nor differentiates the type of antibody detected.
4. Non-Reactive test result indicates absence of HBV infection but does not exclude the possibility of exposure to HBV.
5. False positive results may be observed in patients receiving mouse monoclonal antibodies, on heparin therapy, on biotin supplements for diagnosis or therapy & presence of heterophilic antibodies in serum.
6. False negative reaction may be due to processing of sample collected early in the course of disease, immunosuppression / immunosuppressant cases or presence of mutant forms of HBsAg.
7. Test conducted on serum.

Uses

1. To aid in diagnosis of acute or chronic hepatitis B infection and also in individuals displaying signs of hepatitis in an unknown etiology.
2. To determine the clinical status of HBV infected individuals in conjunction with other HBV serological markers associated with HBV infection.
