Persistence indicates decreasing infectivity suggesting good prognosis for resolution of acute infection. Association of Anti HBe with Anti HBc in the absence of HBsAg and Anti HBs confirms recent acute infection. Anti HBe is an indicator for resolution of acute infection and reduced level of infectivity.
