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Interpretation:

Negative result does not rule out the possibility of infection as only IgM antibodies may be present during the acute phase. Retesting is recommended after 8-14 days. Seroconversion or rising titre indicates presence of active infection.

Comments :

Herpes simplex virus (HSV) is of two types namely Type 1 & Type 2 which present slight antigenic differences. Type 1 virus chiefly causes oral – facial lesions while Type 2 virus is mainly responsible for genital lesions. Asymptomatic infections may occur in healthy individuals and during pregnancy. Severe herpes infections are seen in immunocompromised patients. Infection of neonates during passage through birth canal may result in neurological damage.
