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Interpretation:

1. Ariboflavinosis (dietary deficiency of riboflavin causes a syndrome characterized by sore throat, hyperemia, and edema of the pharyngeal and oral mucous membranes, cheilitis, angular stomatitis, glossitis, corneal vascularization, dyssebacia with dermatitis, and normochromic, normocytic anemia.
2. Severe deficiency can diminish conversion of Vitamin B6 to its coenzyme and curtail conversion of tryptophan to niacin.
3. During recent years, deficiencies of riboflavin and vitamin B6 have been suggested as potentiating factors for chronic progressive nerve compression disorders, such as carpal tunnel syndrome.
